

2013 Sonoma Coast Genevieve's Block Chardonnay

The 2013 Genevieve's Block marks the beginning of what we hope will be a great partnership between Donelan Family Wines and Devoto Vineyard. 2013 is a terrific vintage to lay the foundation for this wine's legacy. The vineyard performed wonderfully this year. Slow maturation and high natural acidity have emerged as hallmarks of the vineyard, resulting in a complex wine. The dynamic between richness and bright acidity make for an exciting mouth feel and distinguish it from most other Chardonnays.

Upfront, our 2013 Genevieve's Block opens with the smell buttery and zesty fresh made lemon bars, wet stone, nectarine and floral peach. It has an angular delivery on the palate with minerality and lanolin. It's full of flavor but refreshing and ready to drink in the next five years.

This block of Devoto Vineyard is on a west-facing hillside above the town of Sebastopol. The Chardonnay ripens slowly under the full weight of the Pacific Coast influence and produces a remarkably elaborate and elegant wine.
