

2011 Sonoma County Cuvée Keltie Syrah

Cuvee Keltie is a blend of the best vineyard parcels and the best barrels of those vineyards. The 2011 is a barrel selection of specific subsections of Obsidian, Richard's Family, Steiner Ranch, and Walker Vine Hill vineyards. The 2011 is a wine of alluring textures with structure and freshness, loaded with aromas of dried cherry, rhubarb, and blueberry preserves. As the wine sits in the glass, it develops notes of crispy lardons, stewed nettles, and dark-chocolate with smoked sea salt. The wine's structure persists at a precise pulse and with the consistent strum of a bass. A finely-tuned instrument, the 2011 Keltie is a serious wine that will captivate both your taste buds and your mind.
