

## 2012 Sonoma County Cuvée Moriah

The 2012 vintage highlights why Grenache is such an exciting varietal to work with and why we love the Dry Stack Vineyard. Although it is rare to find both in one glass, this 2012 Grenache has both power and purity, laser-like freshness, which is a hallmark of our favorites from Chateauneuf-du-Pape.

The Grenache shares the stage with its more exotic cousin, Mourvedre, which furthers the complexity of the blend with ripe pomegranate and grilled game. A select few barrels of Syrah – less than in previous vintages – add depth and richness into the finish, making for an ideal food wine that is also a scene-stealer in its own right.
