This wine is always a fun one for us to put together. We love the free and easy nature of drinking Rosé. It's a wine that immediately conjures images in your head of all the idyllic ways you'll be enjoying it over spring and summer. It's also a wine that holds a uniquely exciting spot in winemaking. Rosé is always the first wine from a growing season to go to market, so it acts as a taste test for the entire vintage. If the Rosé tastes great, then the red and white wines to follow will be wonderful.

Our 2022 Rosé is a blend of Grenache, Pinot Noir, and Syrah. We enjoy the nuances and depth that come from the range of red fruit sources in our portfolio. The presence of different grape varieties helps build complexity and the composition changes with every vintage. This wine splashes you with bright juicy fruit, acidity, and a fresh sea breeze of stately minerality and salinity. The palate is sharp and quenching with a plume of grapefruit and rooibos tea, and a summer essence of strawberry and watermelon. As you taste, you parse out more delicate notes of white flower and lavender lingering around the glass with chalkiness and wet river stone waiting on the palate. When it comes to the countless meals and festivities of spring and summer, you really can't have enough of this Rosé.
