

## 2019 Sonoma County Two Brothers Pinot Noir 92 Points Jeb Dunnuck

The release of the 2019 vintage marks ten years of crafting Two Brothers Pinot Noir. When we set out to produce Pinot Noir at Donelan Family Wines, our desire was to produce a wine that embraces our favorite aspects of great Pinot Noir from Sonoma County.

The 2019 Two Brothers is a young wine. There is a push and pull between the fruit profile and savory elements. The mid-palate is supported by the addition of Devoto Vineyard fruit with its signature

full, fleshy mouth-feel. Earthy and herbal notes of green conifer needles, peat moss, and potter's clay tango with rhubarb and juicy black cherry. This vintage is very fresh with a sexy finish.

Two Brothers is always ready to drink now with a bit of decanting, but time in the cellar will pay off down the road as its young layers unfold into handsome, complex personality. Drink by 2035.
