

2020 Sonoma County Two Brothers Pinot Noir 91 Points Antonio Galloni

2020 was an extremely and abnormally hard year. The pandemic aside, wine country was faced with a harsh fire season. If there's one thing that seemed to escape the curse of 2020, it's Sonoma Pinot Noir. Crop yields were extremely low, but what was picked is already showing great and expected to evolve into a historic vintage of Pinot. The wines from 2020 have great depth, intensity, and strong flavor profiles.

What a triumph for such a difficult year!

The 2020 Two Brothers Pinot Noir greets you with a perfume of Ponzu paste, plum sauce, and graphite. Silky tannin in the mouth is joined by wonderfully juicy acidity, red fruit, orange peel, and Amaro. With time in the glass, additional notes of sweet tea, mulberries, and freshly cut straw unfold. This wine is in such a great spot.
