

## 2021 Sonoma County Two Brothers Pinot Noir 94 Points Decanter

The Two Brothers Pinot Noir is a blend of grapes sourced from multiple vineyards across Sonoma County, with each site contributing its slice of character to the wine. The composition is rooted heavily in Bennett Valley and Russian River Valley lending spice and earth to the nose, while the Sonoma Coast fruit gives an aromatic lift to the wine and brings length to the palate.

2021 is a much-heralded vintage for Sonoma County and one of the best growing seasons in years. The wines are opulent, unique, and of extremely high quality, and our 2021 Two Brothers Pinot Noir is a testament.

The nose of the 2021 Two Brothers is overflowing with cherries jubilee, sweet macerated cherries, and raspberry candy. Spice box and cardamom add a kick to the red fruit profile. The palate has mouth-watering acidity and juiciness with waves of black cherry paste, mocha, sandalwood, and big youthful tannin. This wine is perky and perfumed with great energy and a refreshing finish.
